	smaller than 12 point or larger than 14 point. The essay must be the student's original work.
	This includes all research, writing and editing, which must be done by the student and not
	by a parent, teacher or other helper. Each essay must have a title page listing the following:

	Subtitle may be included
	Contestant's full name and address (school address may be used)
	Contestant's phone number and email address
	Name of contestant's school and grade level
BIBLIOGRAPHY:	Essay must include a bibliography listing all references utilized. The bibliography should be
	cited in a standard, recognized citation style. Internet resources, if used, should be cited in
	the same style, including the electronic address used to access the documet as
	supplementary information. Students are encouraged to use primary sources and cite them.
	Any essay with information copied directly from sources without using quotes will be
	disqualified.
JUDGING AND AWARD:	
	organization of material, interest, originality, spelling, grammar, punctuation, neatness and
	evidence as student's own work. Inclusion of high resolution pictures, maps, drawings,
	graphics and other additions are encouraged but will not be considered in judging. The
	winning essay will be published in the Grand Prairie Historical Bulletin and the student will
	receive a \$250 prize and will be featured at our regular January meeting.
